This year Creativity Week will be a bit different where first half will be devoted to competitive activities and in second half students will have some fun filled non-competitive activities. Participation in all the activities is compulsory. You are requested to inspire and motivate your ward for the same. The schedule for **Class 2** will be as follows:-

CLASS II

COMPETITION/EVENT

26th Nov 2018

1. (a) INTEGRATED QUIZ

- A guiz based on Academics and General Awareness.
- It is a team event.
- Class Quiz team comprising of 4 selected students will take part in Integrated Quiz (I.Q.)
- Four best students will be selected by the class teacher for which a selection round will be held on 19th Nov' 18(Monday)

(b) SHAPELENDAR

- Students will create a table calendar of a month of the current year and prettify it with 2D/3D shapes in any way they like.
- It's an individual activity.
- Material required: As per the requirement.
- Prepared/Ready to use material will not be allowed.
- Judgment criteria: Uniqueness, Creativity and Presentation.
- Duration: 1 ½ hour

Note- Students participating in Integrated Quiz will not take part in Shapelendar.

2. FROM THE PALETTE OF A SRESHTHA

- It is an Individual non competitive drawing and coloring activity.
- The topic will be given on the spot

 All the required material – labeled drawing sheet, clip board, crayons & sketch pen for outlining will be brought by the students.

27th Nov 2018

1. ANGELS AND CHERUBS

- Students of each class will give a stage presentation.
- Theme- Bountiful Nature

Costumes and props as required and instructed by the teacher.

2 (a) RECITE AND ENACT

- One student will recite an English poem and his/her partner will enact it out.
- It is a pair activity.
- Judgment Criteria- Effective recitation, Effective enactment, Synergism(teamwork)
- Four best students will be selected by the class teacher for which a selection round will be held on 22nd Nov' 18.
- Time Limit- 2 to 3 minutes (including introduction)

2 (b) ACTION CITY

- Students will create a 3D city scene or any element of a city like market, stadium, road etc and show at least 5 actions. They will label the actions(handwritten by student) like running, driving, flying etc.
- It is an individual event.
- Material Required- As per requirement (Avoid using readymade material).

28th Nov 2018

1. (a) MONO DRAMA COMPANY

- Students will present a mono act in Hinglish /any regional dialect.
 - (Mono acting is a dramatic presentation of speech, acted by a single actor on stage).
- It is an individual event.
- Theme Swachch Bharat/ Dilwalon ki Dilli/ Breathe free is a Mystery (any one), Props and Costume as per the act.
- Four best students will be selected by the class teacher for which a selection round will be held on 22nd Nov' 18(Thursday). Music will be brought in a pen drive (file name should be student's name) by the student on 20th Nov'18(Tuesday).

- Judgment criteria- Effectiveness, Relevance, Overall presentation
- Time limit- 2 to 3 minutes

(b) HATS OFF

- Students will create a head gear depicting any community helper. They will be expected to creatively present the significance and characteristics of the helper.
- Individual activity.
- Material required- As per requirement
- Judgment Criteria- Innovation&Creativity, Visual appeal, Relevance
- Duration- 1 ½ hours

Note- Students participating in Mono Drama Company will not take part in Hats Off.

2. KAARYSHALA

- To encourage hands on learning through a workshop which will be conducted by teachers on varied topics like art & craft, dance, music, drama etc.
- Material Required: Origami Sheets ,Clay,Colours.

29th Nov 2018

1. (a) हँसी के फ़व्वारे

- Hindi poem recitation activity.
- It is an individual event.
- Theme Funny and tickling poems.
- Four best entries will be chosen by the class teacher for which a preliminary round will be held on 20.11.18.(Tuesday) (no props required)
- Time Limit 2-3 minutes (including introduction).
- Judgment Criteria- Content, Intonation and Presentation.

1. (b) बोलते चित्र

- Children will read a story given on the spot and draw and colour a picture depicting the story.
- It is an individual activity.
- Material required- A-4 size white cartridge sheet (labeled), crayons, sketch pens.
- Decoration material is not allowed.
- Judgment Criteria –Creativity, Neatness, Overall presentation.
- Duration- 1 ½ hours

Note- Students participating in हँसी के फ़टवारे will not take part in बोलते चित्र.

2. PLEASURE TRIP

- Students will be taken to a nearby park for a picnic.
- Various games and activities will be organized to facilitate learning outside the realms of a classroom.
- Time duration- School hours

30th Nov 2018

1. (a) SHOW YOUR MOVES

- Students will present their talent of any western dance form(hip hop, salsa, jive, robotic etc) on any western song(instrumental/vocal).
- It is an individual event.
- Four best entries will be chosen by the class teacher for which a preliminary round will be held on 20.11.18.(Tuesday)No costume or prop is required for preliminary round.
- Judgment Criteria- Performance, Choreography, Costume/Props
- Time Limit-2-3 minutes.

(b) FACE TO FACE

- Students will create a pair of 3D human faces of any nationality (Indian, South East Asian, African etc.)
